Biden, 79, named the late congresswoman while thanking lawmakers from both parties for their efforts in helping his plan to end hunger in the United States. 'Jackie, are you here? Where's Jackie?' the president questioned during the White House Conference on Hunger, Nutrition, and Health in Washington, DC on Wednesday after also calling out Senators Mike Braun, a Republican, and Cory Booker, a Democrat. 'She must not be here,' he concluded. The White House was also scheduled to play a video tribute to her during the event. Walorski was among the four people killed in a head-on collision on August 3, 2022 when returning from a ribbon-cutting ceremony in Claypool, Indiana. The other deceased were the driver of the other vehicle as well as two staffers in the lawmaker's office, communications director, Emma Thomson, and her district dir
