'Killer jock' school football star, 17, whose millionaire dad tried to 'cover up his role' in murder of boy, 16, beaten to death outside Halloween party - as cops apologize for giving family valet parking at court

Seven young men including high school football star Talan Renner, 17, have been charged in the brutal murder of Preston Lord, 16, who was found critically injured on a Queen Creek road after being attacked at a Halloween party in October. Authorities took months to name the suspects, with enraged locals demanding justice for months and claiming the young boys' powerful families were preventing justice from being served. Ashley Reynolds, who worked for Talan's father Travis Renner, has claimed she was an unwilling participant in a coverup that allegedly began as soon as Lord was critically injured. The former employee at the media company told Arizona Republic that her bosses Travis Renner and Adam Kifer, CEO of Relentless Media Agency, openly discussed their plans to hide evidence and shift blame on another boy. Preston's murder highlighted a growing cases of group violence by teenagers in the Phoenix area and other towns in Maricopa County. Police have said a street gang dubbed 'Gilbert Goons' were attacking teenagers and robbing stores.

Kaylee Gain (left) is 'fighting hard to stay alive' after having suffered a skull fracture and frontal lobe damage when her head was repeatedly smashed into the ground during a brawl (right) near her St. Louis high school last Friday. She was left alone on the ground to convulse before EMTs arrived. The family say Gain (inset) has 'major brain bleeding and swelling' and is in 'critical condition'. They will not know the full extent of the damage until she wakes up. A GoFundMe created in support of Gain has raised nearly \$200,000 in just two days.
