
Sanders Blames Clinton for Not Informing People About Russian Meddling: 'They Had More Information About This Than We Did'



Sen. Bernie Sanders (I., Vt.) said Wednesday that he did not know at the time that Russian trolls proceed his 2016 presidential campaign and wondered why Hillary Clinton's team did not do more to tell vote the extent of Russia's election interference.

In addition to their well-known efforts to boost Donald Trump, Russian trolls supported Sanders' presprimary campaign, when he mounted a surprisingly strong but ultimately unsuccessful challenge to according to special counsel Robert Mueller's indictment from last week.

Mueller's team indicted 13 Russian nationals and three companies for interfering in U.S. elections fr to 2016.

In an interview on Vermont Public Radio, Sanders took issue with a listener's question that made it s if he knew about Russian bots promoting his candidacy at the time he was running.

"If he was aware that Russians were trying to promote him and divide Democrats against Mrs. Clintor did he not communicate this to his supporters?" the listener asked Sanders.
