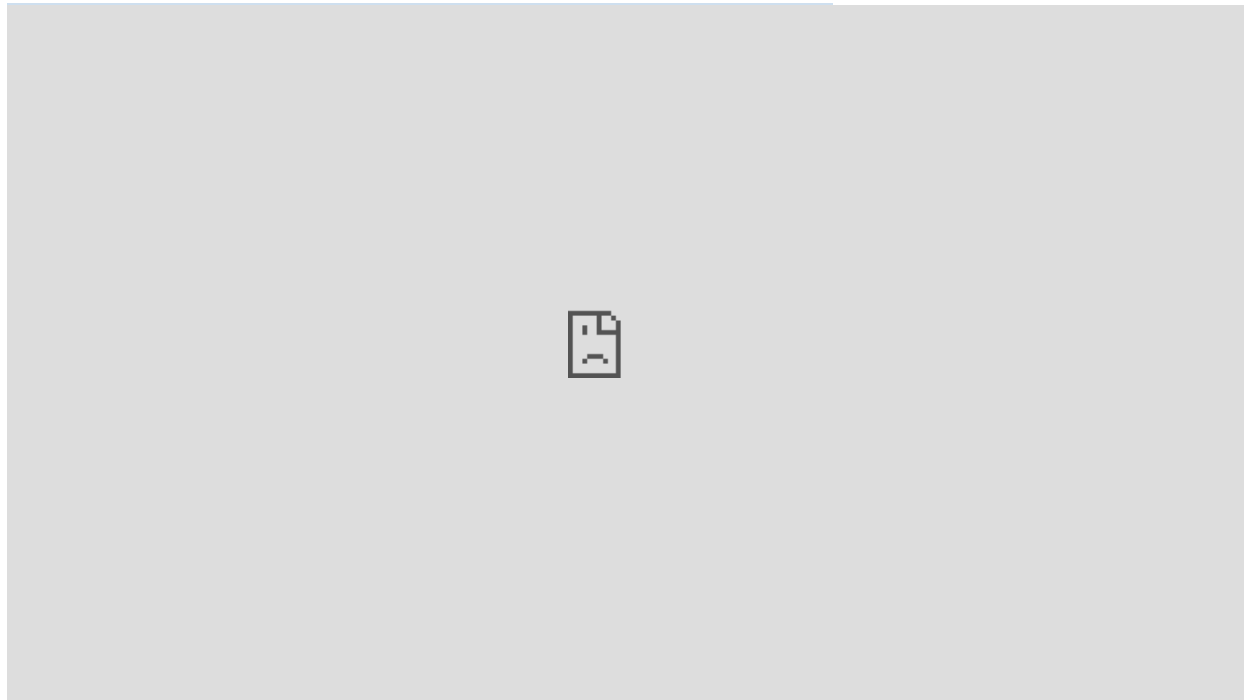


FBI official says bureau leaked stories, then used them to get FISA warrants
